

# Trio Kórena

Trio Kórena is a young ensemble recognized by Jeunesses Musicales of Catalonia with the 2025 La Flama Award, which includes their debut at the Palau de la Música Catalana and their incorporation into the Xarxa de Músiques a Catalunya (Catalonia Music Network) 2026/27. They are winners of the 1st prize at the 17th Higiní Anglès Competition, the 2nd prize at the 27th Josep Mirabent i Magrans Competition, the Accessit Prize at the 25th Pòdiums Competition, and the Audience Award at the 5th Cambra Romànica Competition in Andorra.

It was formed in 2020 at the Superior Conservatory Liceu, where they completed a Master's degree in Chamber Music Performance with Catherine Ordonneau and Isaac Rodríguez.

Recognized with a scholarship by Jeunesses Musicales of Germany, they have participated in the prestigious 70th International Chamber Music course at the Weikersheim Musikakademie, receiving masterclasses from Vogler Quartett and Dirk Mommertz.

They received a scholarship to participate in the NMICMF course, taking masterclasses with Vlad Stanculeasa, Darío Mariño, and Georgy Tchaidze. Selected for the 8th International Quartet Academy, they have received classes from violinist Abel Tomàs and Gerhard Quartet, and have participated in international courses in Portugal and Italy, receiving masterclasses from Luc-Marie Aguera, Darío Mariño, Pascal Moragués, and Péter Nagy, among others.

Furthermore, they have received masterclasses from pianists Katharina Sellheim and Raimon Garriga, from violinists Kai Gleusteen and Paolo Andreoli, member of the Quartetto di Cremona, and from Jordi Francés.

They have performed various concerts throughout Catalonia, such as at the Royal Catalan Academy of Fine Arts of Sant Jordi, the Círculo del Liceo (organized by maestro Roger Alier), Casa Elizalde, Auditori Barrades, and in various civic centers and churches, among others. They were selected to participate in the 4th Professional Day for Chamber Ensembles, performing at the Auditori de Girona.

They have been invited to play at the Itinera Festival, the 19th Musiquem International Festival, and in several concert cycles such as Afinitats, Música Z, Clàssica a Horta-Guinardó, Divendres Jove at the Auditori Eduard Toldrà of the CMMB, the Aprenents Cycle of Joventuts Musicals de Sant Cugat, and the Dimarts Concert Cycle of the EMMEixample.

The Kórena Trio has worked with Catalan composers such as Salvador Brotons and Jordi Cervelló.
